To enter Makkah, all Muslims from outside Saudi Arabia are required by law to apply for a visa from the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia embassy or consulate, except for citizens of countries belonging to the Cooperation Council for the Arab States of the Gulf (GCC): Kuwait, Bahrain, United Arab Emirates, Oman and Oatar.
